



On-site deployments – Members should have the following items ready for rapid response, especially at mass casualty scenes, depending on the situation.

- Go-kits for Medical volunteers:
  - Contact information of the Incident Manager and MRC Deployment Staff
  - Notebook and pen
  - Badge or government ID
  - List of emergency contacts
  - Insurance cards Sweater or sweat shirt
  - Copy of directions and Job Action Sheets
  - Any forms needed for the deployment
  - Back-pack
  - Safety scissors
  - Nitrile gloves
  - Face masks for PPE (including N95, if possible)
  - Pocket mask or face shield for resuscitation
  - Eye protection
  - Gown
  - First Aid supplies (bandages, sterile wipes, other)
  - Generic salve (Neosporin/bacitracin)
  - Small bottle of sterile water
  - Pen lights
  - BP Cuff and Stethoscope (members bring their own, if they have these)
  
- Personal items for all volunteers:
  - Contact information of the Incident Manager and MRC Deployment Staff
  - Notebook and pen
  - Badge or government ID
  - List of emergency contacts
  - Insurance cards Sweater or sweat shirt
  - Copy of directions and Job Action Sheets
  - Any forms needed for the deployment
  - Bottled drinking water (16-oz)
  - Snack bars
  - Personal Items you may need
  - Extra socks
  - Leather or canvas work gloves
  - Work boots
  - Personal medical supplies (such as diabetic meds and snacks)
