### Seasonal Influenza Clinic Results for October 2009

---

During the month of October, there were three EDS style Seasonal Influenza Clinic at Cary Hall, which were staffed by Medical Reserve Corp Volunteers, Board of Health members, various town employees and Office of Community Development Staff. There were Three Hundred Fifty Six (356) and Six Hundred Ninety Seven (697) adults vaccinated for Seasonal Influenza on October 16, October 30 and October 31<sup>st</sup>. Additional clinics will be planned as soon as Seasonal and H1N1 vaccine becomes available over the next few weeks.

Below, you will find a few photos from the October 31<sup>st</sup> 2009 clinic. In addition you will also find a chart, which outlines the number of citizens who were vaccinated with either *Flu Mist* or *Inject able* Seasonal Influenza vaccine which are reported by specific age groups.

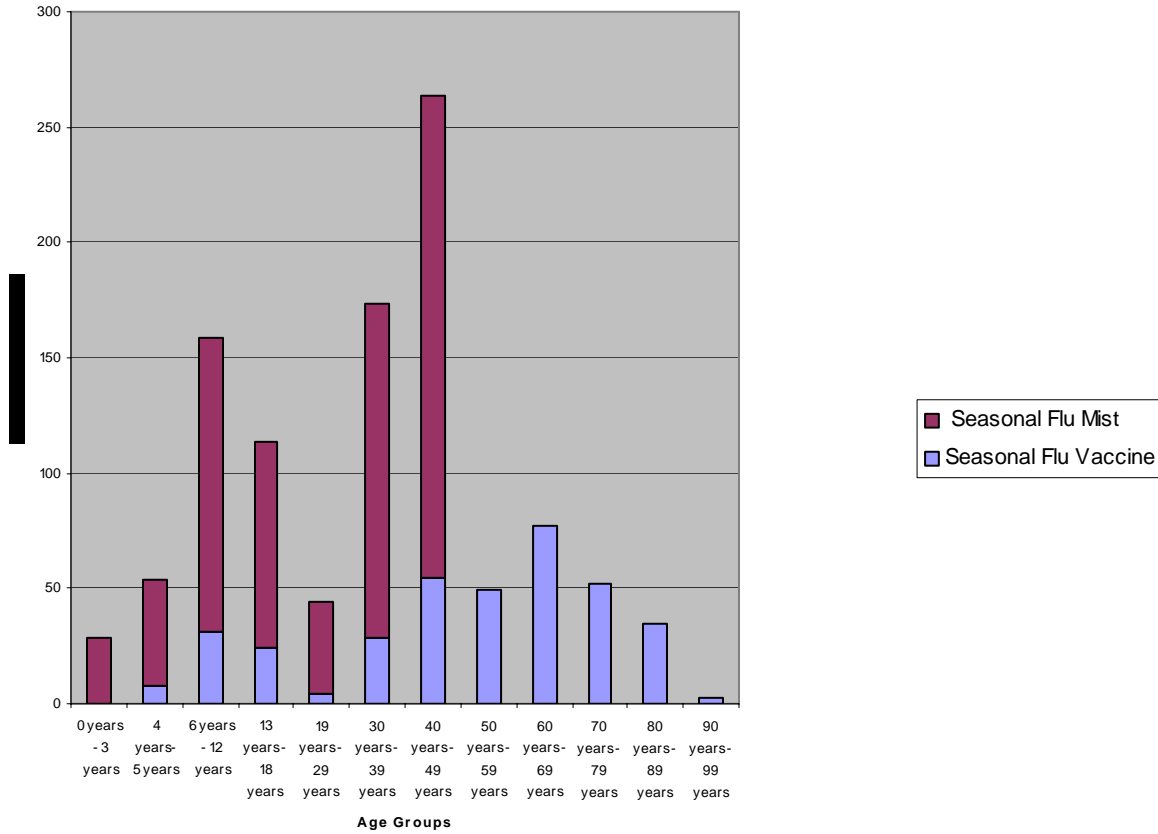
