H1N1 Influenza Clinic Results for November 22, 2009

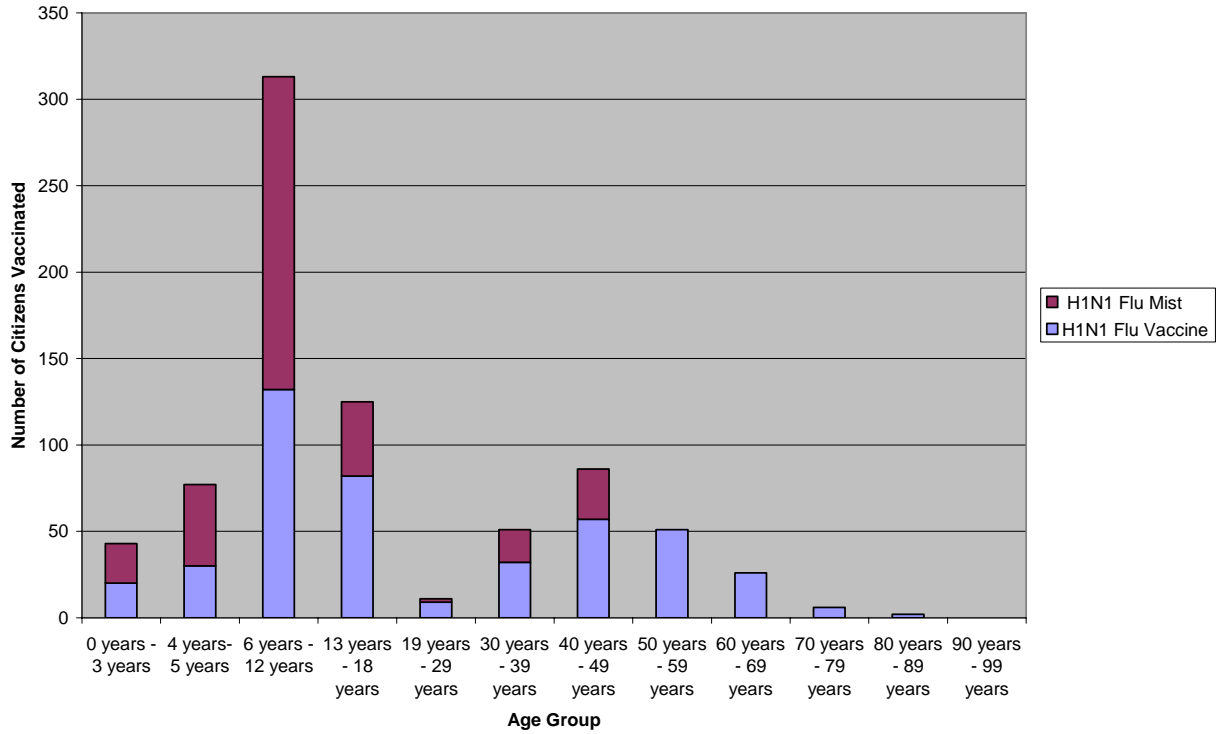
On Sunday November 22, 2009, an EDS style H1N1 Influenza Clinic was held at Cary Hall, which was staffed by Medical Reserve Corp Volunteers and Office of Community Development, Health Division employees. There were Five Hundred Ninety Two (592) children and One Hundred Ninety Nine (199) adults vaccinated for *H1N1 Influenza*. Additional clinics will be planned as soon as *Seasonal and H1N1* vaccine becomes available over the next few weeks.
